Get Rid of Screens in Schools and Let Teachers Teach by returning to a traditional hands-on, phonics-based education without all the other government red tape and excessive regulations.

Unite Minnesotans Under One Flag by putting the Northstar Flag on the ballot so that we can collectively choose to move past the partisan divide.

Restore Trust and Participation in Democracy by implementing proportional representation, free universal voting IDs, and weeklong election periods.

End the Income and Inheritance Taxes by taxing the richest and removing so much burden and friction from our small businesses.

Prioritize Local Businesses by challenging the notion that it's unconstitutional to prioritize their residents' businesses over foreign corporations.

But none of these arguments get made unless you can help me win the Republican primary on August 11th and replace establishment thinking.
